Cycle Parking

Although the application fulfills the minimum standard for the number of cycle parking spaces required for such a development, the allocated space is located in an obscure corner at the rear of the site with no obvious access to or from outside the development. The space does not lend itself to accommodating non-standard cycles such as tandems, cargo bikes or bike trailers. The difficult location does not encourage its use.

We are all being encouraged to cycle more due to the COVID-19 restrictions now, and in the future to improve health and well-being. Therefore the provision for cycle parking should go beyond the minimum standard.
