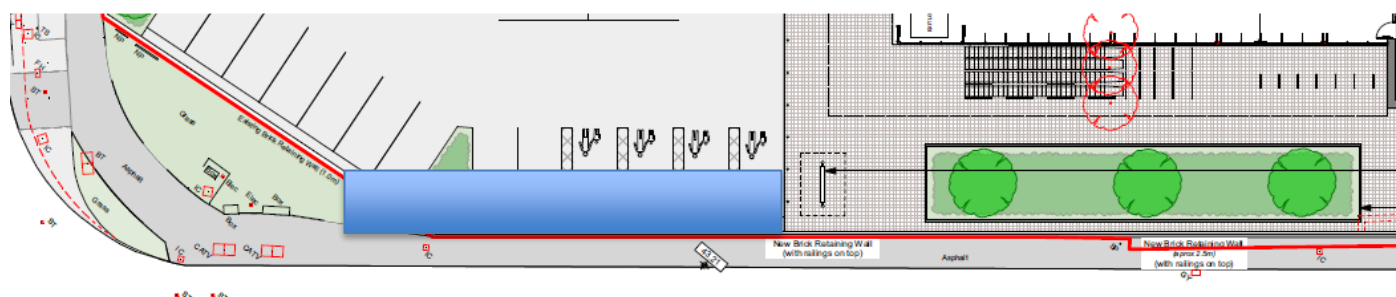

Dear Mr Jeffrey

Exeter Cycling Campaign objects to this development proposal due to the inadequate cycle access as follows:

There is no mention of cycle access on the submitted plans, but I assume it is intended to be along the proposed pedestrian access off Exhibition Road. This access is potentially dangerous as it includes a diagonal zebra crossing across the car park. Firstly a diagonal crossing is non-standard and secondly there will be cars reversing over the crossing when they enter and exit the adjacent car park spaces. This will clearly be dangerous for pedestrians and cyclists.

I suggest a far safer and attractive entrance for cyclists and pedestrians could be formed by a ramped access along the Pinhoe Road boundary as shown below in blue:
